

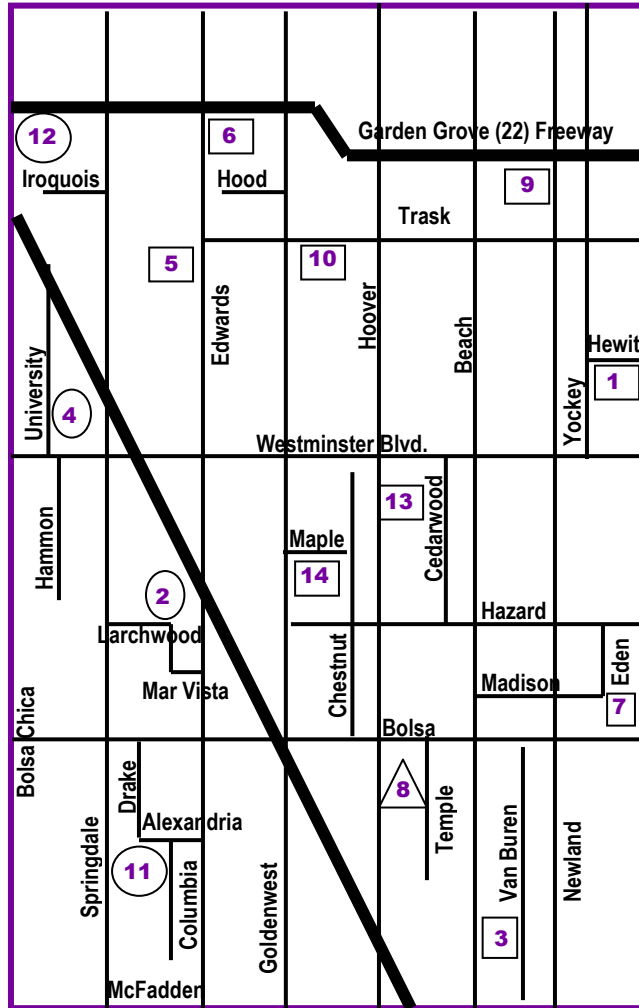

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

*In response to the needs of the community, over 1000 children attend a Westminster School District preschool program.*

### State Preschool

The State Preschool is a 3-hour school readiness program for 3-4 year old children. The goal of this program is to increase the number of children entering the school system ready to learn. Participation is free for income-eligible families. Children must be 3 or 4 years of age by December 2<sup>nd</sup> in order to qualify. Priority registration is given to 4-5 year olds who will be starting kindergarten the following year. The program begins the first day of the new school year and lasts 180 days. Parents must volunteer in the classroom twice per month.

### School Readiness Parent Participation

A 3-hour preschool program is available, 8:15 - 11:15 a.m., Monday through Friday. The overall goal of this program is also to increase the number of children entering the school system ready to learn. Parents must volunteer at least twice per month in the classroom. Participation is for children who will be turning 4 years of age by December 2<sup>nd</sup>. The program begins the first day of the new school year and concludes the last day of school. The program is closed in observance of district holidays and school breaks. Please call for rates.

### Child Development Center

The Land Child Development Center is a full-day, year round program operating 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Participation is for children who are 2 1/2 years old by December 2<sup>nd</sup> and are potty trained. Staff provides developmentally-appropriate instruction in the areas of Reading/Language Arts, Math, and socialization, all of which are designed to prepare each child to enter Kindergarten ready to learn. **Tuition assistance is available for those who qualify.** Please call Sue Fode at (714) 898-8389 for rates and more information.



### Parent Education & Involvement

Parents are highly encouraged to participate in district-sponsored parent education opportunities located at your child's school. Each year the Westminster School District and the Child Development Programs offer a wide variety of parenting trainings. Parents are also highly encouraged to volunteer in the classroom.
